## ~Itinerary~

### Day 1 Depart USA

Depart from New York or Washington on South African Airways overnight flight to Johannesburg

### Day 2 Cape Town

Arrival Johannesburg, connecting flight to Cape Town and meet your guide for transfer to the Cape Grace Hotel for the next 3 nights. Balance of day/evening on own.

### Days 3 & 4 Cape Town

A full schedule of sightseeing over the next two days includes the famous Cape Peninsula, Table Mountain and Robben Island. Take a fascinating look at South African's ethnic heritage and post-Apartheid progress.

### Day 5 Johannesburg

This morning depart Cape Town to Johannesburg. On arrival meet your guide to explore the 'City of Gold' including Freedom Square, Nelson Mandela's former home, and the vibrant township of Soweto. Return to The Grace Hotel, this evening.

### Day 6 & 7 Private Game Reserve

Transfer to the airport for your flight to the Sabi Sands and Mala Mala Main Camp a private reserve bordering the Kruger National Park with local transfer to the safari lodge. Meet your ranger who will share their wealth of knowledge as they introduce you to the game reserve's diverse wildlife, prolific bird species and unique vegetation. ### Day 8: Johannesburg / Departure
