

CHOBE SAFARI LODGE



On Botswana's far northern border lies the Kwando, Linyanti and Chobe river system forming a series of lakes, islands and floodplains. This area forms the Chobe National Park, famous for its large buffalo and elephant herds. Chobe Safari Lodge is situated 3 km from Kasane International Airport and 80km from The Victoria Falls & Livingstone. In addition to a

variety of predators, there is an abundance of wild game and bird life which decorate these beautiful waterways. We have recently renovated our lodge and now boast a great new dining, swimming pool and bar area.

The newest additions to Chobe are the 32 safari rooms. Individually decorated, they offer every comfort. Each safari room affords guests the luxury of air-conditioning, luxurious en-suite bath and shower facilities, as well as satellite TV. The luxurious twin-bed river rooms are air-conditioned and offer the convenience of phone, TV and large en-suite bathrooms. Family rooms include two twin bedrooms. The thatched rondavels are independently positioned, with ceiling fans and en-suite bathrooms. The famous Chobe Safari Lodge campsite has a first-rate ablution area and facilities along the banks of the river.
