

THE NORFOLK HOTEL



Fairmont The Norfolk Hotel has played a leading role in Kenya's colorful history, and continues to be Nairobi's finest and best-known hotel. The town and later the modern city of Nairobi grew up around Fairmont The Norfolk hotel, which still has its own private tropical gardens. The hotel is still the traditional starting point for safaris and the Lord Delamere Terrace is modern Nairobi's most famous

meeting place, where drinks and light meals are served continuously from morning until midnight.

All rooms are luxuriously furnished with plush carpeting, working desk with HSIA, as well as a private en-suite marble bathroom. Also, Smoking rooms have a 4-piece bathroom (tub and shower). The non-smoking rooms have a 3-piece bath. Deluxe Rooms feature a veranda. An in-room safe is provided in selected rooms. Most of the Fairmont Rooms (28) have two twin beds and 5 of them have a King bed. Moderate Rooms offer great value in a luxury hotel. These historic rooms in the Karura wing offer HSIA, 1 King or 2 Twin beds, a desk and a private en-suite bathroom. All guest rooms have common amenities including air-conditioning, bedside lamp, dressing table, electrical mosquito repellent, hair dryer, luggage rack, refreshment center, safety deposit boxes, telephone (direct dial), television with satellite, and wardrobe (built-in).



The Norfolk offers extensive recreation facilities. The outdoor heated pool is surrounded by lush gardens. An attendant mans the pool from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The Health & Fitness Centre is located above the poolside restaurant. Trained professionals staff the facility. Services include aerobics classes, one-on-one training and registered massages. The fitness centre offers state-of-the-art equipment including free weights along with treadmills, lifecycles and nautilus machines. Separate facilities for men and women include changing

rooms with showers, steam bath, sauna and restrooms. The Aberdare Country Club is located at The Norfolk's sister hotel and it is the perfect choice for those seeking a truly unique golf experience. There is also the Royal Nairobi Golf Club. Established in 1906, the Royal Nairobi Golf Club opened shortly after The Norfolk. The two have shared strong ties ever since.
