

Relais Du Masoala



Situated 1,5km outside of Maroantsetra, one of Madagascar's most authentic towns, is the beautiful Relais du Masoala. Nestled in seven hectares of gardens and coconut groves, this well managed establishment also boasts views over the Bay of Antongil. Entirely constructed with local material and perfectly integrated in its environment, the

Relais de Masoala will seduce you by its calm, its quality of service and authenticity.

Fifteen thatched bungalows, situated in a grove of coconut trees, provide spacious accommodation with en-suite facilities and private verandas overlooking the bay. Each of Relais du Masoala's rooms has a shady verandah.



Nosy Mangabe is a big attraction here and Relais du Masoala can arrange day and overnight visits by boat. Other trips either along the peninsula, or upriver from the hotel can also be organised through the hotel. Bird watching in the Masoala Peninsula, pirogue excursions up river, whale-

watching in September, visits to the small forest near the hotel where the aye-aye lemur can be seen, cultural experiences to the local village, and canoeing and mokoro trips are also offered. There is a relaxed dining room and bar and a swimming pool.
