

Tsara Guest House



Tsara Guest House is a beautiful boutique hotel situated in the upper town of Fianarantsoa. For over a decade the Tsara Guest House has been the most popular hotel in Madagascar. It is located in an old house that began its life as a church and boasts a terrace

offering wonderful views of the town. The owners, Jim and Natalie, work hard at providing all the comforts and atmosphere that traveler's desire.

The Guest house has eighteen tastefully decorated rooms split between the main building and a separate annex. All of the rooms vary in size, but all are tastefully styled and have en suite bathroom facilities with a shower and toilet. The more expensive spacious rooms offer beautiful views over the distant rice paddies. The guest house has a small restaurant offering the best in local cuisine and a small garden and bar area, which is the best place to spend the warm Madagascan evenings.



Although the town itself is vibrant with many craftsmen working within it and tea plantations a short distance away, Tsara Guest House is often a stop for people on the route between Isalo National Park and Antananarivo, or those on the way to Ranomafana or Andringitra National Parks. Fianarantsoa is a pretty academic town. You can discover it by walking through its windy streets and old houses built with

bricks and tiles. Around you can see lakes, vineyards, and the unique tea plantation in Madagascar.
