The lodge has ten individually-designed villas spread out along a lush hillside overlooking the lake. Each villa boasts a large bedroom, a spacious living area and a private deck with lake view. Their distinctive grass roofs reflect the heat of the African sun while the simple and elegant interiors ensure comfort and privacy. Each of the villas is different, varying in size from a generous 125 square metres up to 175 square metres.
