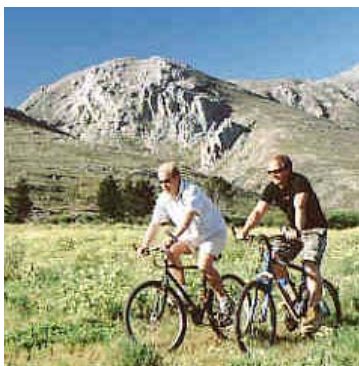


Blue Gum Country Estate
