

The Taj Cape Town



Situated in the historic centre of the city, the Taj Cape Town is a combination of rich history and elegant contemporary architecture. Originally home to the South African Reserve Bank and Temple Chambers, later the Board of Executors (BOE), it successfully combines the heritage of the old with the luxury of the new. This luxury five-star hotel is ideally located in the centre of historic Cape Town at the entrance to the famous Pedestrian precinct, St George's Mall and is perfectly situated for those looking to discover authentic Cape Town; and its blend of fascinating history, exotic culture, soulful art, lively entertainment and delectable cuisine. Spread across two

Heritage buildings, the Taj Cape Town retains the original marble pillars, vaulted ceilings, glass domes and architectural elements of the legendary Temple Chambers and the South African Reserve Bank Building. Its new Tower dramatically rises above the city skyline.

The historic structure of the Taj Cape Town is home to the Heritage Rooms and Suites, Tower Rooms and Suites, The Presidential Suite and the Taj Club. These 166 exquisite rooms offer guests a blend of sophistication and luxurious comfort. While the Heritage rooms are classically designed and are located within the historic structure of the hotel, all the Tower Rooms have floor to ceiling glass facades and private balconies, from where guests can enjoy splendid views of the city or Table Mountain. The second floor, of the Taj Cape Town, is dedicated to the Taj Club, which consists of 13 rooms. Here guests have exclusive use of the private Club Lounge, with seating for up to 25 guests.
