

Tsala Treetops



Tsala Treetop Lodge, a symphony of stone, wood, glass and water high above the magnificent indigenous forests of Tsitsikamma. It lies in the heart of the Garden Route of the Western Cape, about 10km from Plettenberg Bay. Tsala Treetop Lodge is an exclusive lodge catering for only twenty guests, staff are attentive and hospitality superb. Wooden walkways meander through the trees to 10 individual, elevated suites in the forest

canopy. The main lodge is connected to the suites by a series of elevated walkways. There is a cozy lounge with views of the forest and valley.

The lodge boasts large open suspended decks for dining and sunset viewing. There is a library featuring reference books on the area and the cellar is stocked with the best South African wines. The unique modern structures of Tsala Treetop Lodge rise out of the ruins of a mystical ancient civilization that may have existed here. The legend that has been created imparts an atmosphere of adventure and romance. Arriving at the Porte Cochere, along the cobbled approach road, you follow the boardwalk past the fountain, across the reflection pond and into the imposing Tsala Treetop Lodge.

Each suite offers a sitting room with wood fire, spacious bathroom, outside shower, and private pool with observation deck and lounge chairs.



There are many activities at Tsala Treetop Lodge for guests to enjoy at their own leisure. These include nature walks, private swimming pool, bird watching, nearby beaches, close to coastal resort towns, horse riding, whale and dolphin watching, shopping, canoeing or kayaking, or just staying where you are and utterly relaxing.
