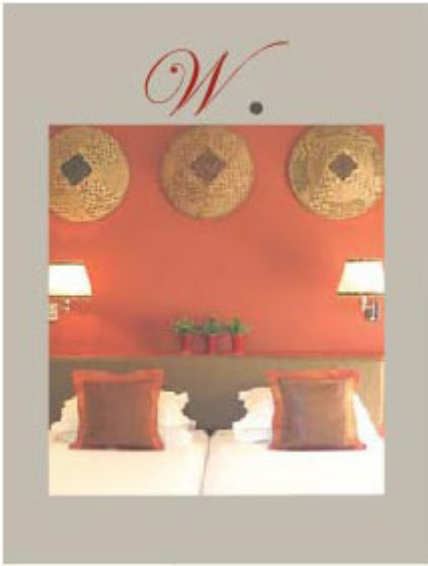


Welgelegen Guest House
