

Lukula Camp



We, at Lukula Selous, endeavour to tread very lightly over this unique landscape and minimize our impact leaving a legacy that not only nourishes the present but invests in this area for the future. We do not operate to any fixed itinerary but pick up on the rhythm of the wilderness around us. The Selous Game Reserve is 55,000sqkm and is one of the largest wildlife sanctuaries anywhere. Selous is world

renowned for its wild character and large populations of elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard, and African wild dog. Within this special place, deep in its southern reaches and far from anyone else, is Lukula Selous, a 300,000 acre area that only allows one group into the entire area at any one time. Privacy and freedom is what Lukula is all about. Only a few privileged, small groups and individuals have the opportunity to explore this wilderness in complete privacy freedom under expert guidance.

The camp has only four luxurious and spacious sleeping tents arranged along the Luwego River bank. Each tent is authentic and stylish with beautifully worked pieces of campaign furniture made from recycled hardwoods, brass, and weathered canvas, softened with carpets, cushions and colors brought inland from Zanzibar and afar. En-suite facilities feature large open air bathrooms with bucket showers, flush toilets, wash basins and vanity stand. Hot water is available upon request 24 hours a day. Each room has large comfortable beds, luxurious line, full length mirrors and standing fans.



A spacious comfortably appointed dining tent under shade provides an intimate and beautiful area to relax and dine. Our sundowner tent is located out on the banks of the river and away from camp providing the perfect place to unwind and enjoy the late afternoons. Also, Lukula offers a number of sleep-out options which include fly camping on the banks of the river after a day's kayaking – or even enjoying a night or two camping out

and away from main camp on a fully portered safari. The focus at Lukula is connection with the landscape and its wildlife. This can be from 4x4 vehicles, on foot and in an inflatable kayak. An open, fully equipped land cruiser allows us to transport ourselves and our equipment around the area and gives a great opportunity to do night game drives. The fly-camp is lightweight and carried by porters. It is comfortable and gives a great authentic bush experience under the stars.
