Bushmans Kloof, the heartbeat of an African wilderness . . . the rebirth of a long forgotten land. Immense open plains, deep ravines, spectacular waterfalls and prehistoric rock formations characterize this ecological oasis, nestled between the majestic mountains of the Cederberg and the vast plains of the Great Karoo. 270 Kilometres north of Cape Town. In recognition of its rich cultural, historical and environmental significance, Bushmans Kloof has been declared a South African Natural Heritage site.

Luxury Accommodation

Each of the seven luxury rooms are double (or twin) with a private patio overlooking the landscaped indigenous gardens, and with access to a nearby swimming pool. Manor House - 4 suites, lounge and fireplace, television room, bar, dining room, covered veranda.
