*Antananarivo (Tana), with its brightly colored houses stacked up the hillsides, mauve jacarandas and purple bougainvillea, is an attractive capital city. The rice paddies and zebu-carts on the outskirts provide a stark contrast to the noisy traffic, bustling markets and colorful people in the narrow cobbled streets of the city center.*

### Days 1 ~3 Antananarivo

Spend three days in Tana and two nights at the beautiful Hotel Colbert. Enjoy the relaxing atmosphere as you spend your days shopping and sightseeing at the artisan market, Tsimbazaza Museum and Botanical Garden. The artisans' market shows an enormous array of quality Malagasy handicrafts including woodcarvings, raffia work, embroidered tablecloths and Antaimoro paper. In the evenings enjoy Tana's lively mixture of excellent restaurants, bars and nightclubs.

The Hotel Colbert is located in a nice area in the upper town of Antananarivo and offers a unique blend of French tradition and enchanting Malagasy hospitality. All rooms are equipped with satellite television, radio, mini-bar, tea/coffee making facilities, telephone and ensuite bathrooms. The hotel
