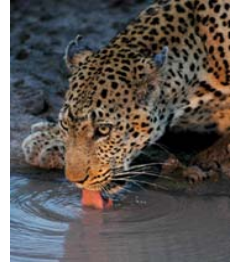


Jewels of the Cape

~ Itinerary ~

Day 1: Cape Town

Arrive Cape Town, meet & greet by local Guide and transfer to your hotel. This afternoon relax or perhaps explore the Waterfront museums, shops and restaurants. Accommodations: The Cape Grace Hotel

Day 2: Cape Peninsula

This morning depart on a full day tour of the Cape Peninsula. See the spectacular scenery of Chapman's Peak and Cape Point. Choose to visit the penguins at Boulders Beach by kayak, take a boat cruise in Hout Bay home of thousands of Cape fur seals, or experience a guided encounter with a troop of Chacma baboons. Lunch at Coastal Bay then head out for your choice of family friendly afternoon excursions like visiting the Cape Point Ostrich Farm, Imhoff Snake & Reptile Park or experience the World of Birds. Day 3: Cape Winelands

Today take a private family excursion of the historic Winelands. Enjoy tastings of South Africa's high quality red and white wines visiting estates which offer child-friendly activities. Stroll through exotic gardens surrounded by beautiful butterflies at Butterfly World, lunch at one of the many classic restaurants in the area then finally end your tour with an up-close and personal encounter with the cheetahs at Spier Estate. Day 4: Cape Town City Tour & Table Mountain

This morning enjoy a half day tour of the city and weather permitting; a ride up Table Mountain on a revolving cable car. Next the family will love a visit to the Two Oceans Aquarium before lunch and a browse through the local craft centers. Return to the hotel in the afternoon.

Day 5 & 6: Grootbos Private Nature Reserve

Transfer along the Garden Route to the award winning Grootbos. Kids reign supreme at this reserve. Your many adventures here can include whale-watching only meters off your boat, horseback riding through the largest milkwood forests in the world. Travel to the island refuge of huge sea bird colonies and nesting grounds of the rare African Penguin. Admire Cape Fur Seal colony, watch dolphins play in the wake of your boat and be amazed by the awesome spectacle of a great white shark breaking the surface of the water.

Day 7 & 8: Eastern Cape, Kwandwe Private Reserve

Continue along the Garden route past Pt Elizabeth to the Kwandwe Private Game Reserve. Stay in Kwandwe's newest sole-use villa, Melton Manor, a contemporary Eastern Cape homestead set in a beautiful location overlooking the river and afro-montane forests. Melton Manor has a large swimming pool and central courtyard and is the perfect escape for family safaris. Here's your chance to see the Big Five on Safari; Elephant, Rhino, Buffalo, Leopard & Lion.

Accommodations: Melton Manor B/L/D

Day 9 Departure

Return transfer to Pt Elizabeth for your onward flight.
