

Adventurer Exploration Botswana with Wilderness Safaris



Migration Routes

9 Nights/10Days

Experience a nostalgic camping safari that recreates a sense of wildlife adventure reminiscent of the times of the early African explorers, taking you back to the bygone days of Africa's exploration. Adventurer camping aims to bring you closer to nature, with lively campfires, hurricane lanterns, diverse activities and a warm atmosphere permeating the camp's simple comforts and pristine wilderness!

Day 1: Natural Mystic Lodge, Zambia

Arrive Livingstone and Natural Mystic Lodge, ten ensuite thatched chalets overlooking the Zambezi River. Nature's sounds of birdlife, frogs, baboons, monkeys and hippo create a mystical mood, while free-roaming elephants are frequent visitors to the grounds. Enjoy an afternoon guided tour of the Victoria Falls, one of the Worlds seven Natural Wonders.

Day 2, 3 & 4: Chobe River & Linyanti Concession

Morning departure for Chobe National Park in Botswana famous for its vast herds of elephants and unique species such as the elusive puku and Chobe bushbuck. Over the next two days enjoy boat cruises, canoe trips and game drives in this myriad of changing landscapes and sweeping views.

Day 5, 6 & 7: Lechwe Island Camp Okavango Delta

Travel through the Chobe National Park with stops for game sightings and lunch. This long but interesting drive gives the perfect introduction to the varying habitats of a dry and flat northern Botswana, from the open savannah of the Savute Marsh with its granite hillocks to the geographically interesting Selinda Spillway (Great Rift Valley fault line). Arrive at Lechwe Island Camp in the Selinda private concession. Activities concentrate around the bushy and wooded islands, open plains and the flooded and dry channels surrounding the camp with game drives, night drives and walks.

Day 8 & 9: Xigera Mokoro Trails, Okavango Delta

Light aircraft flight to the water-filled paradise of the private Xigera area, within the Moremi Game Reserve, the ultimate Delta experience. Travel by mokoro to experience the serene waters and innumerable channels of the Okavango and its diverse plant and animal life. Key to the experience is mobility, with smaller guest tents with a gauze main frame to enhance the views, and bedrolls are on the ground (and not on a stretcher). Activities include mokoro and walking safaris, which enable up-close encounters with the excellent diversity of birdlife (including Pel's Fishing Owl), frogs and a myriad of game species.

Day 10: Transfer to Maun Airport

Bid farewell to the adventure as we transfer by light aircraft to Maun Airport.

Winter itinerary - 01 June to 30 November

Summer itinerary (01 Dec to 31 May) has a one night switch from Linyanti Trails Camp to Savute Marsh, Chobe National Park.
