## 3 nights/4 days



*Spend three nights in the largest protracted tract of raw wilderness in Africa, home to the continents greatest populations of elephant, buffalo, hippo, crocodile and one of the worlds last remaining concentrations of wild dog and black rhino.*

### ~Itinerary~

#### Day 1, 2 & 3 Sand Rivers Selous

Take a scenic flight from Dar to Selous Air Strip. You will be met at the Selous Airstrip and transferred to the most remote and luxurious lodge in Selous, the Sand River Selous. Here, it's not what you see, it's how you see it. In the Selous, game viewing takes on a slower pace. Whether its walking safaris, fishing, boating, game drives, or a combination of all these, its possible, exciting & rewarding at Sand Rivers. Spend a lazy afternoon in one of our hides, concealed beside waterholes, where guests are a silent and unobtrusive audience to the drama unfolding on this vast African stage.

For the more adventurous, fly camping offers the outdoor experience of a lifetime. Large mosquito nets are laid out on sand banks or near to a busy waterhole. Simple yet fully equipped, these camps have ice cold drinks, great food, comfortable bedrolls, and toilets & bucket showers set just behind the camp; it's the perfect combination of intrepid adventure and bush comfort. Each camping spot is chosen for its view or the game in the area and allows you to utterly absorb yourself in the Selous wilderness.

The river provides an utterly unique view of life in the Selous and Sand Rivers. Upstream the river narrows into a deep ravine called Steigler's Gorge, the steep sides thick with lush forest and huge boulders where leopards are often seen and monkeys leap through the treetops. Downstream of the lodge the river is wide and expansive with vast tracts of sandy banks, home to monitor lizards and bee-eaters. The lodge has several aluminum boats to take you out for daily river adventures.

#### Day 4 Safari Ends

Your adventure ends with a return transfer to airstrip for coastal air flight to Dar es Salaam
