

Safari for All Seasons

8 Nights / 9 Days



Southern Africa offers seasons of contrast; rains in summer brings profusions of new plants game giving birth to their young, opportunistic predators take advantage. Colorful migrant birds arrive and dormant plants burst through the soil while flowers and fruits abound. In the winter dry months animals are gripped in the epic struggle of survival along major wetlands and rivers. This safari offers a spectacular year-round experience that takes in three countries and a variety of ecosystems with their attendant wildlife and scenery encompassing Botswana's Kalahari Plains, the Okavango Delta, Namibia's Caprivi Strip and the stupendous Victoria Falls.

Days 1 – 3 : Kalahari Plains, The Central Kalahari

Depart from Maun by lite aircraft into the Central Kalahari Game Reserve This prehistoric riverbed, flanked by petrified dune lands, is very appealing after brief rains, as it is covered with nutritious grasses that attract herds from all over the enormous reserve.

Days 4 & 5: Seba, Jacana or Xigera Camp, Okavango Delta

Lite aircraft flight in the Okavango Delta represents the extreme contrast of a water-filled world in an otherwise arid desert; abundant water, sunlight and salt combine to form a paradise bursting with life. The difference between the Kalahari and Okavango becomes amazingly clear even as we fly from the one to the other. Accommodation on this leg is at either Jacana, Xigera or Seba Camp, all situated in the heart of the Okavango Delta's myriad waterways Permanent water all year round allows one to enjoy a variety of activities; sit back in a mokoro (dugout canoe) and silently glide through the tranquil Okavango waterways or watch the sunset and birds gliding home to roost from a motorboat on the Xigera Lagoon. The more adventurous can enjoy a scenic nature walk.

Days 6 & 7 Mudumu National Park Namibia

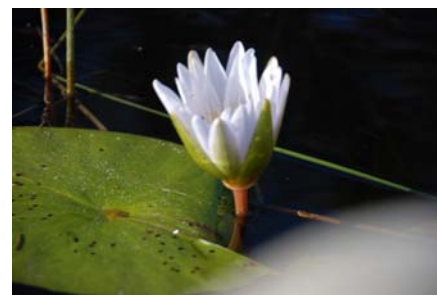
Depart by lite aircraft and enjoy a boat ride on the magnificent Kwando River before arriving at scenic Lianshulu Lodge situated in Namibia's Mudumu National Park. The lodge is an idyllic place in beautiful surroundings. Activities include boat rides, nature drives in the park and visits to the traditional village over the next two days.

Days 8: Victoria Falls Livingstone Zambia

After breakfast depart for Livingstone by road and arrive this afternoon to either Toka Leya or River Club both on the border of the Mosi oa Tunya National Park. Activities include game drives, boat rides and fishing.

Days 9 : Livingstone Departure

Take a guided tour of Victoria Falls, one of the seven natural wonders of the world, then transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
